

## The Arizona Abortion Access Act Amendment

may appear on the <u>ballot</u> in <u>Arizona</u> as an <u>initiated</u> <u>constitutional amendment</u> on <u>November 5, 2024</u>.

This ballot initiative would establish the fundamental right to abortion that the state of Arizona may not interfere with before the point of fetal viability (defined as the point of pregnancy when there is significant chance of the survival of the fetus outside the uterus without the application of extraordinary medical measures) unless justified by a compelling state interest (defined as a law or regulation enacted for the limited purpose of improving or maintaining the health of the individual seeking abortion care that does not infringe on that individual's autonomous decision making).
